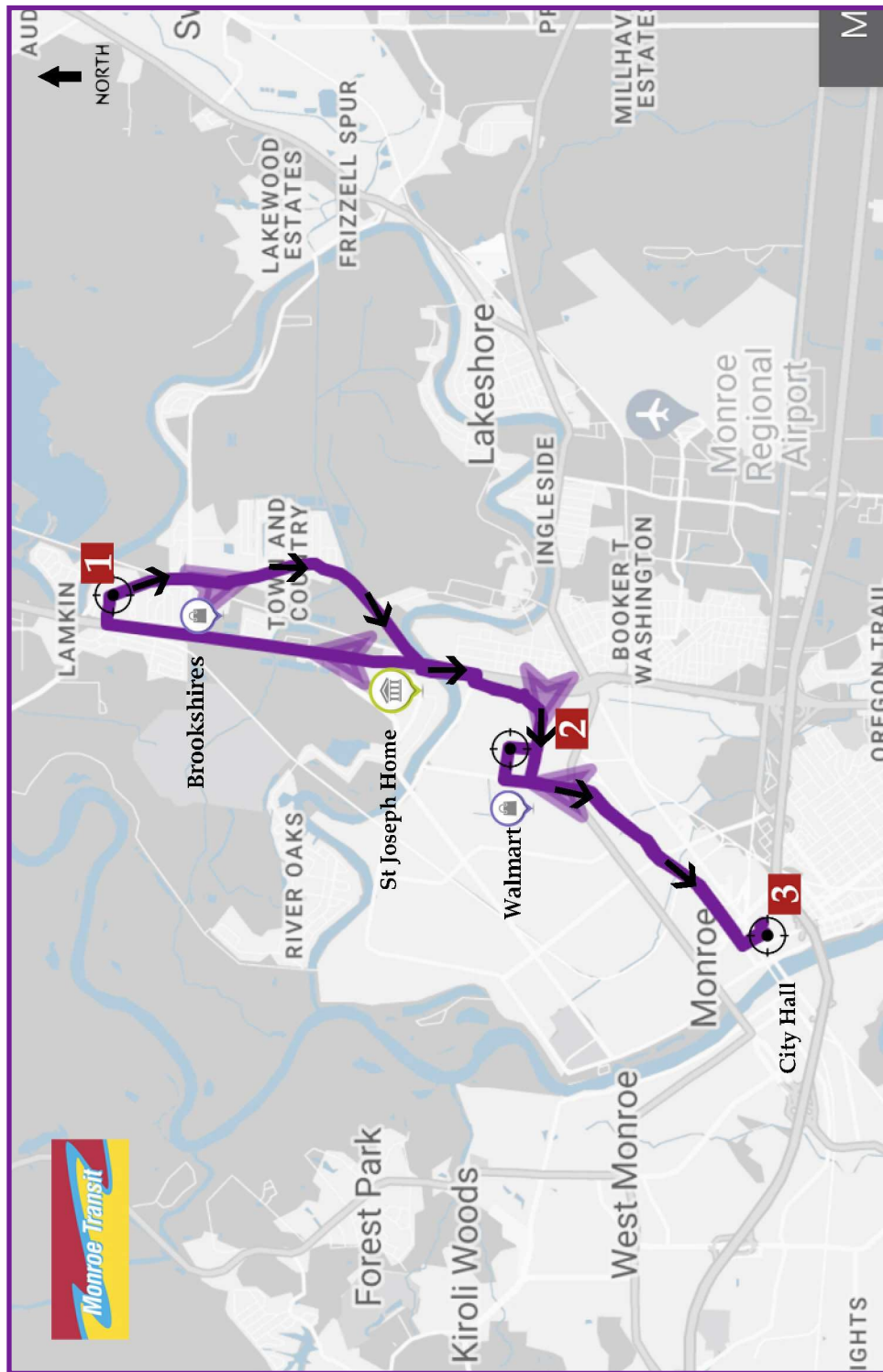

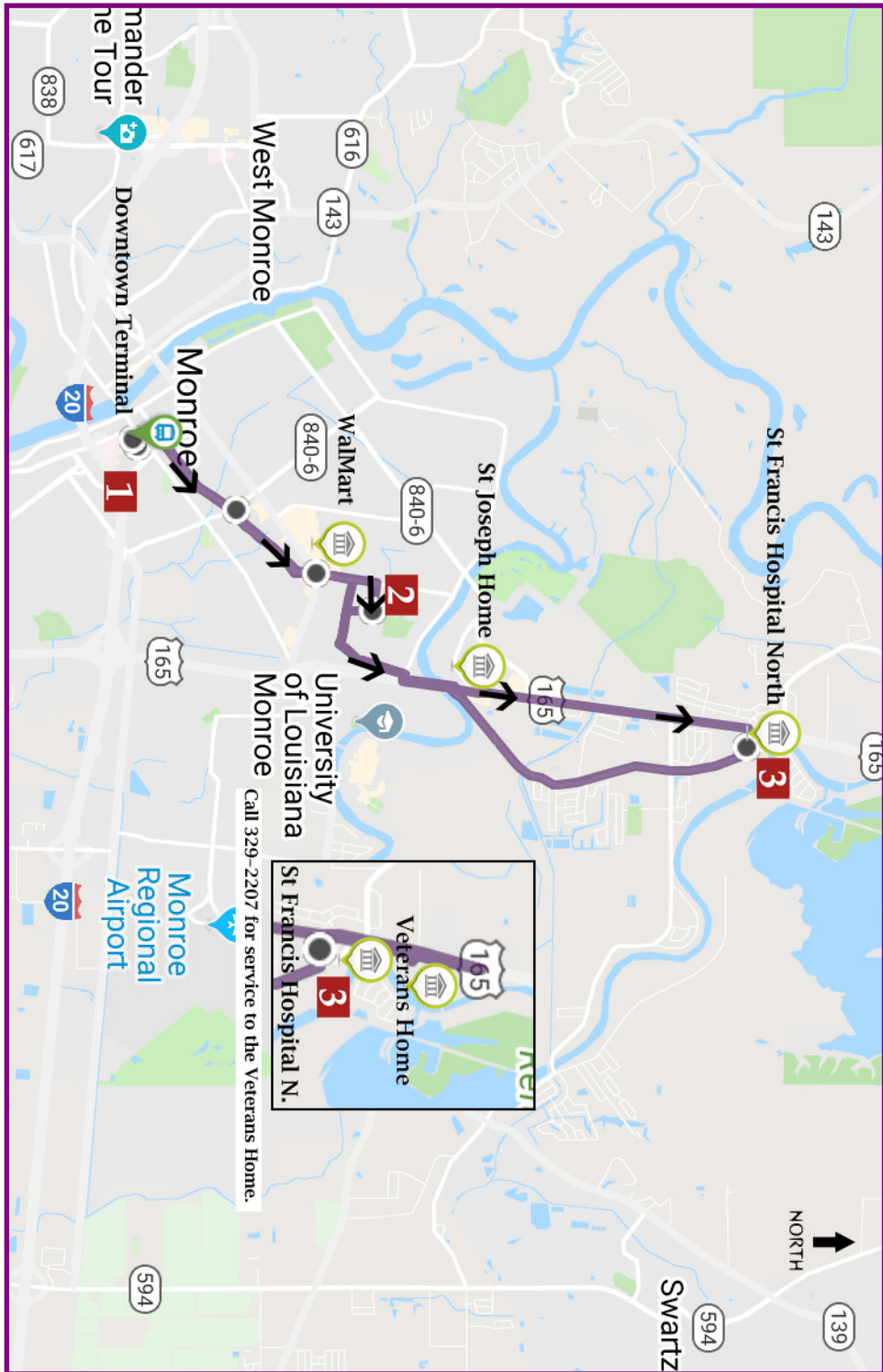

Buses do not operate on: Sundays, New Year’s Day, MLK Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, Fourth of July, Veterans Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

PASSES/TICKETS

MTS offers passes and tickets to make it even more convenient to ride with us. Passes can be purchased at the MTS facilities (207 Catalpa St & 700 Washington St) or online at <https://portal.mtsbus.org/app/tickets/>.

Transfer Information: To complete your one-way trip, you may transfer from one route to another, with a transfer which is obtained from your driver when you pay your initial fare. Transfers are valid for a limited time (15 minutes) or until your next connecting bus. Transfers are only valid at the Downtown Terminal.

Half-Fare Program: An MTS ID is required for half fare. ID’s available for free at the MTS Main Office (700 Washington St.) with proof of one of the following.

- Elderly: Any person 62 years or older
- Disabled: Any person with a disability through an application process
- Medicare: Any person possessing a Medicare card pursuant to Title II/XVII of the Social Security Act
