If more than 15,000 barrels per year are produced, it will be considered light manufacturing. The facility may include an accessory tasting room where customers can taste samples of the products manufactured on-site and purchase related sales items. A maximum of 10% of production can be sold in the tasting room and any sale of alcohol in the tasting room or otherwise in the facility which is manufactured outside the facility is prohibited. The tasting room may only be open three (3) days a week with minimum hours of operation. A craft brewery does not include restaurants with accessory brewing facilities or microbreweries.
