This letter is in response to the request for review of possible regulatory requirements for the proposed bore of Bayou DeSiard for the installation of a sewer force main associated with the Kansas Lane extension project, located in Monroe, Ouachita Parish, Louisiana.

Based upon the information provided (enclosure), we have determined that a Department of the Army Section 404 permit will not be required for the proposed work, since the boring of Bayou DeSiard is not a regulated activity under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act. Also, please be advised that if any associated work (road, levee construction, land clearing, land leveling, etc.) is conducted along with the proposed work, a reevaluation of permit requirements is required by this office. In addition, we are not addressing geographic jurisdiction for this non-regulated activity.

This determination of Department of the Army regulatory requirements does not convey any property rights, either in real estate or material or any exclusive privileges, and does not authorize any injury to property or invasion of rights or local laws or regulations, or obviate the requirement to obtain State or local assent required by law for the activity discussed herein. The decision regarding this action is based on information found in the administrative record, which documents the District's decision-making process, the basis for the decision, and the final decision.
