DEFINITION/DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS OF JOB:

The Diesel Mechanic is responsible for maintaining the upkeep of all city buses and other Monroe Transit System vehicles.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Will be responsible for removal/repair/rebuilding 8.2 series, 8.3 Cummins and 6V-92TA Detroit Engines and Allison transmissions.
- Will be involved in troubleshooting and repairing, automatic transmissions, air brakes, and other bus mechanical systems.
- Will be involved in the repair of air conditioning systems and preventative maintenance inspection of buses.
- Hours will vary from 5:00 A. M. to 10:00 P. M., Monday thru Saturday.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

- · High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Must have a copy of your Social Security Card
- Must have a copy of your Driver's License
- Must have a copy of a current Motor Vehicle Report
- Experience in diesel engine rebuilding necessary with at least two (2) years' experience.
- Must own tools for diesel engine repair with rolling cart.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Knowledge of electrical, air brake, and air conditioning systems desirable.
- Must be able to work with minimum supervision.

LICENSES and CERTIFICATIONS:

- Prefer ASE Certified.
- Must have a Class B CDL License with a Passenger Endorsement and Air Brakes and with no violations for three (3) years.
