DEFINITION/DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS OF JOB:

Under the supervision of the Traffic Superintendent, Traffic Signals Crew Leader, and/or Tech II, this position serves as a trainee Traffic Signal Tech while learning procedures. This is the first level in the Traffic Signal Services Series.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Serves as a trainee Traffic Signal Tech while learning procedures.
- Services, loads, and unloads vehicles.
- Operates an aerial lift truck and other work vehicles.
- Installs and secures traffic signal equipment and hardware.
- May be required to manually dig holes for strain poles and anchors.
- May be called to assist in the operation of other Engineering crews and/or the operation of the Traffic Engineering office and facilities.
- Operates a variety of electrical hydraulic and manual hand tools.
- Provides a safe, courteous, and effective service to the public.
- Works well with all other departments and divisions of the City.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

- High School diploma or GED
- Must have or be able to obtain within 1 year an IMSA Level I certification in Traffic Signals or higher

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Thorough working knowledge of assembling, adjusting, testing, and programming of the traffic signals and control devices and materials in service in the City of Monroe.
- Proficient in knowledge of electrical procedures.
- Able to read, understand and apply electrical circuitry.
- Prepares work order forms and written daily reports to turn into Supervisor within 24 hours of performed work or next scheduled workday.
- Maturity and good reasoning skills.
- Able to understand, follow, and issue oral and written instructions.
- Able to operate hand tools.
- Able to perform multiple tasks.
- Able to prepare written activity reports; organize and maintain records and information.
- Must be punctual and dependable with good attendance and work habits.
- Maintains thorough knowledge of maintenance procedures and techniques.
- Maintains physical stamina, manual dexterity, eye-hand-foot coordination, form, and spatial perception.

- Maintains a pleasant personality and communicates easily with the public; diplomacy, tact, and professionalism required.
- Good penmanship, strong grammar, and spelling skills desirable.

WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Required to ascend and descend in an aerial lift truck.
- Works mostly outside in various weather conditions.
- Exposed to noise, dust, dirt, unpleasant odors, gases.
- Requires standing, bending, crawling and moderately heavy lifting.

CALLOUTS AND OVERTIME:

- THIS POSITION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE ROTATION FOR CALL-OUTS. THIS POSITION WILL BE PAID FOR ACTUAL CALL-OUTS AND OVERTIME WITH DOCUMENTATION.
- The regular job duties of this position include being On-Call and available for Callouts.
- It is an essential duty of this position to be included in the On-Call rotation with 30-min response time to Callouts, 24/7.

LICENSES AND CERTIFICATES:

- A valid State of Louisiana Driver's License is required.
- This position must receive an IMSA Traffic Signal Technician I certification, or higher within one year of being hired.
