**DEFINITION/DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS OF JOB:**

*Under general supervision, the Vehicle & Equipment Mechanic II is responsible for performing engine and body repair of average difficulty on both gas and diesel equipment; is responsible for proper care of shop equipment and may supervise helpers; performs related work as required.*

**EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:**

- Diagnoses engine malfunction causes and determines necessary repairs on gasoline and diesel-powered equipment including garbage trucks, automobiles, buses, tractors, trucks, draglines, motor graders, bulldozers, grade-all front-end loaders and pumps
- Performs major and minor overhauls
- Inspects and repairs hydraulic systems, transmissions, differentials, electric circuits, clutches, starters, brakes, and drive and suspension systems
- Performs minor repairs, tune-ups, and maintenance
- Performs welding on automotive parts or body
- Maintains records of repairs completed
- Performs body work and paints damaged sections.

*Considerable experience in gas and diesel equipment repair and maintenance work, including some experience at the journeyman level.*

- Skill in use of hand tools and power tools used in repair of gas and diesel equipment
