DEFINITION/DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS OF JOB:

Under the general supervision of the Community Centers & Programs Director, the eSports & Gaming Coordinator is responsible for developing, promoting, and facilitating the needs associated with the gaming clubs and organization. May be under the direct supervision of the designee of the Director of Community Centers & Programs.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Assists in providing a variety of opportunities for student involvement in activities related to eSports, gaming, and virtual events.
- Implements and hosts open gaming events and tournaments for the community.
- Promotes events and activities through various marketing strategies.
- Ensures the eSports equipment is properly used and maintained.
- Acts as a first contact for all patrons and creates an inviting, exciting atmosphere.
- Manages the eSports areas, including maintenance of equipment.
- Directs and coordinates all eSports events hosted by the City of Monroe
- Performs related tasks as required by the Director.

- Possesses a high school diploma or GED from an accredited institution.
- Familiar with eSports and Gaming activities and marketing.
