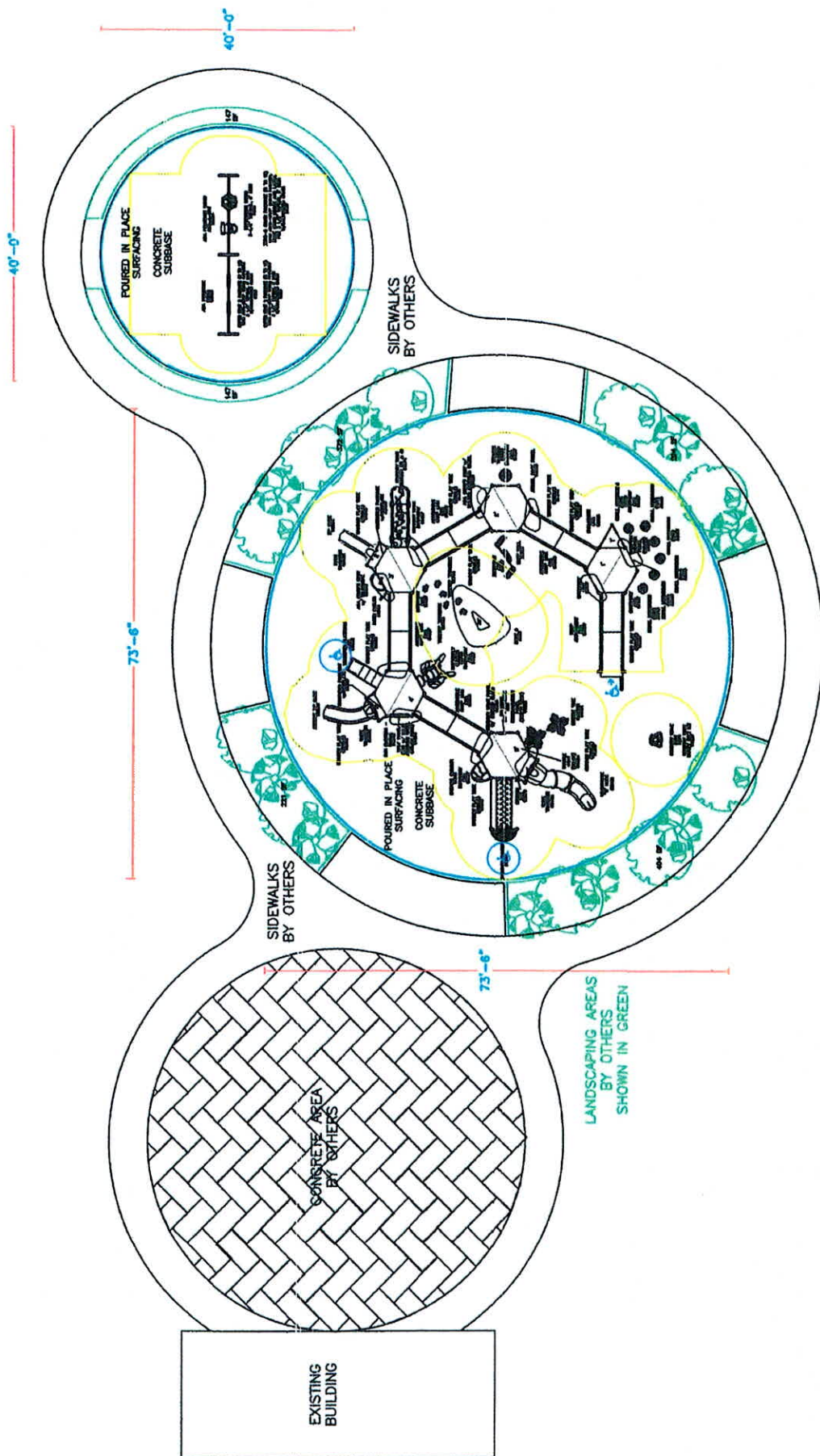
REQUEST:

This is a presentation by the City of Monroe regarding their intentions to demolish and rebuild the existing children's playground area. The playground area is in the 2400 block of Sycamore Street, within Forsythe Park. This is a proposal to construct new playground apparatus and swing set equipment.

The changes would be implemented in a way to maintain the aesthetics and historic district.

The new playground equipment will be constructed in the same area as the previous play area, on the west side of Sycamore Street. No additional parking spaces will be provided with this project. Landscaping, green spaces, and walking paths will be incorporated within the project, as indicated in the attached site plan. 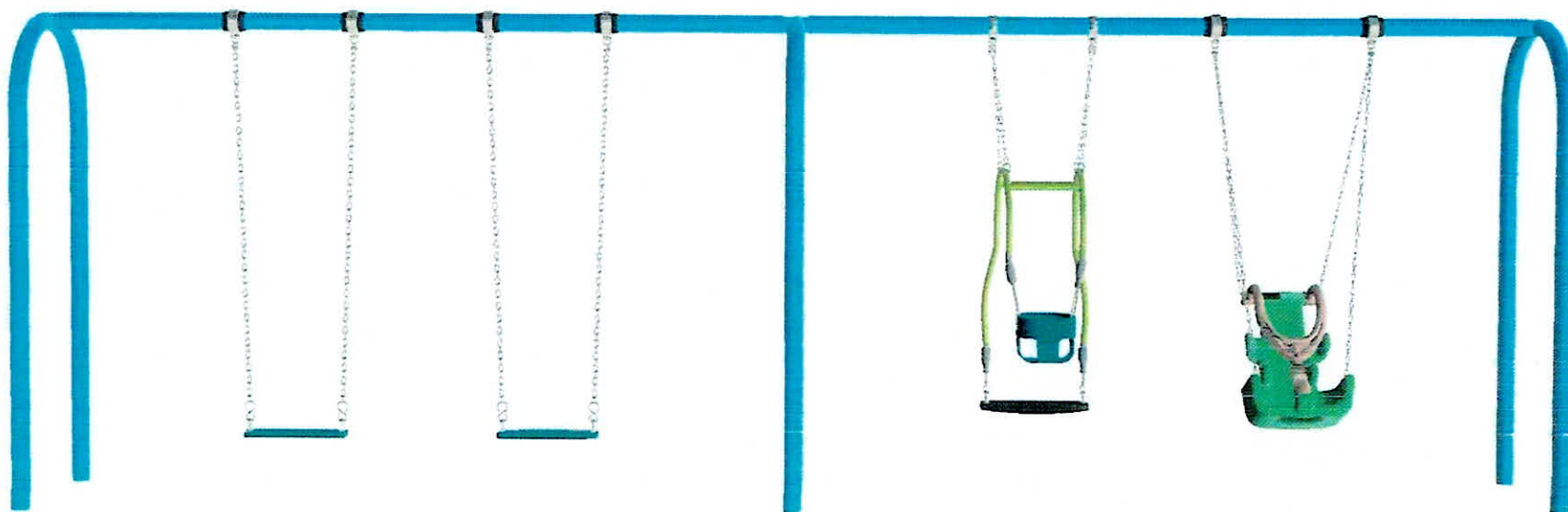

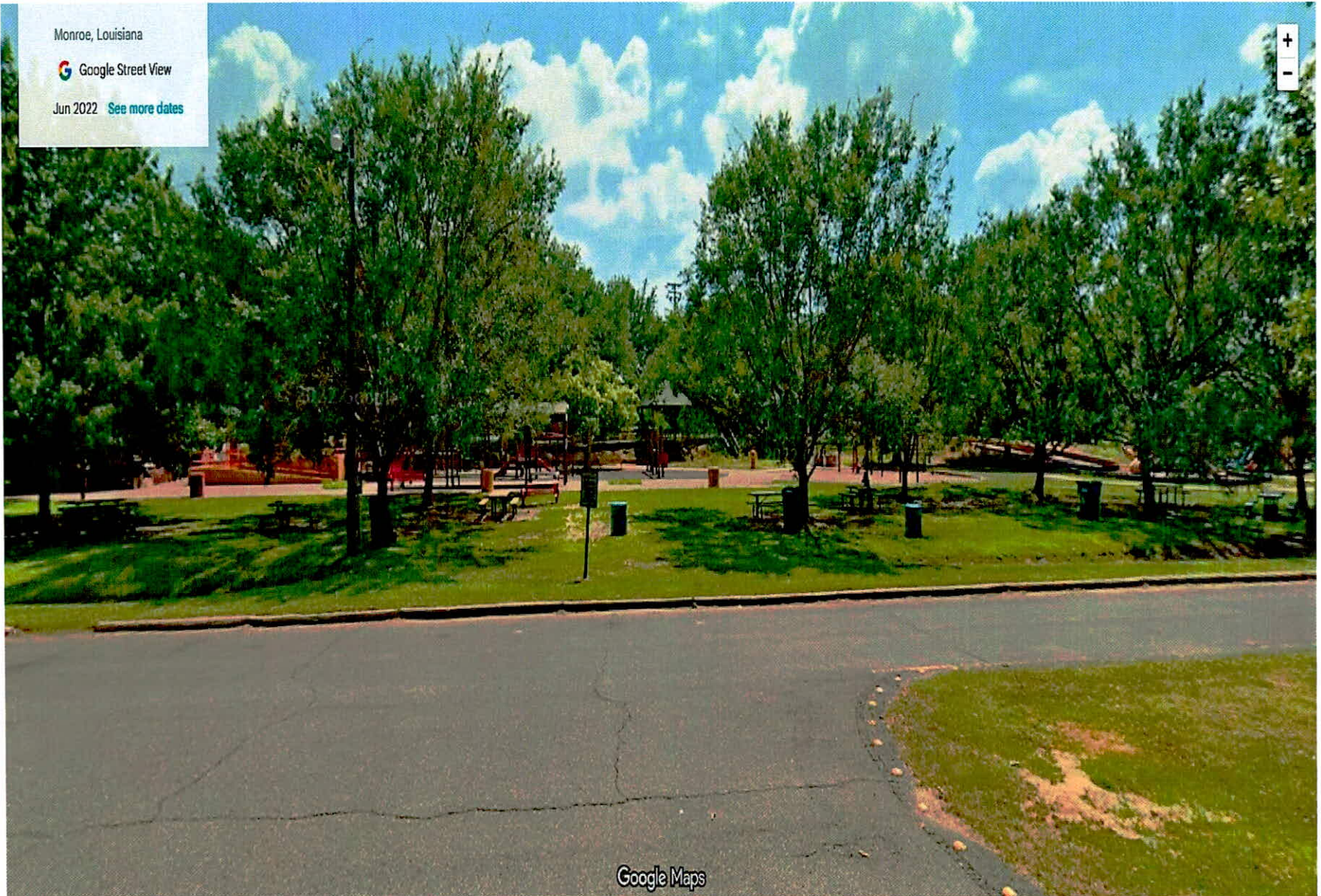

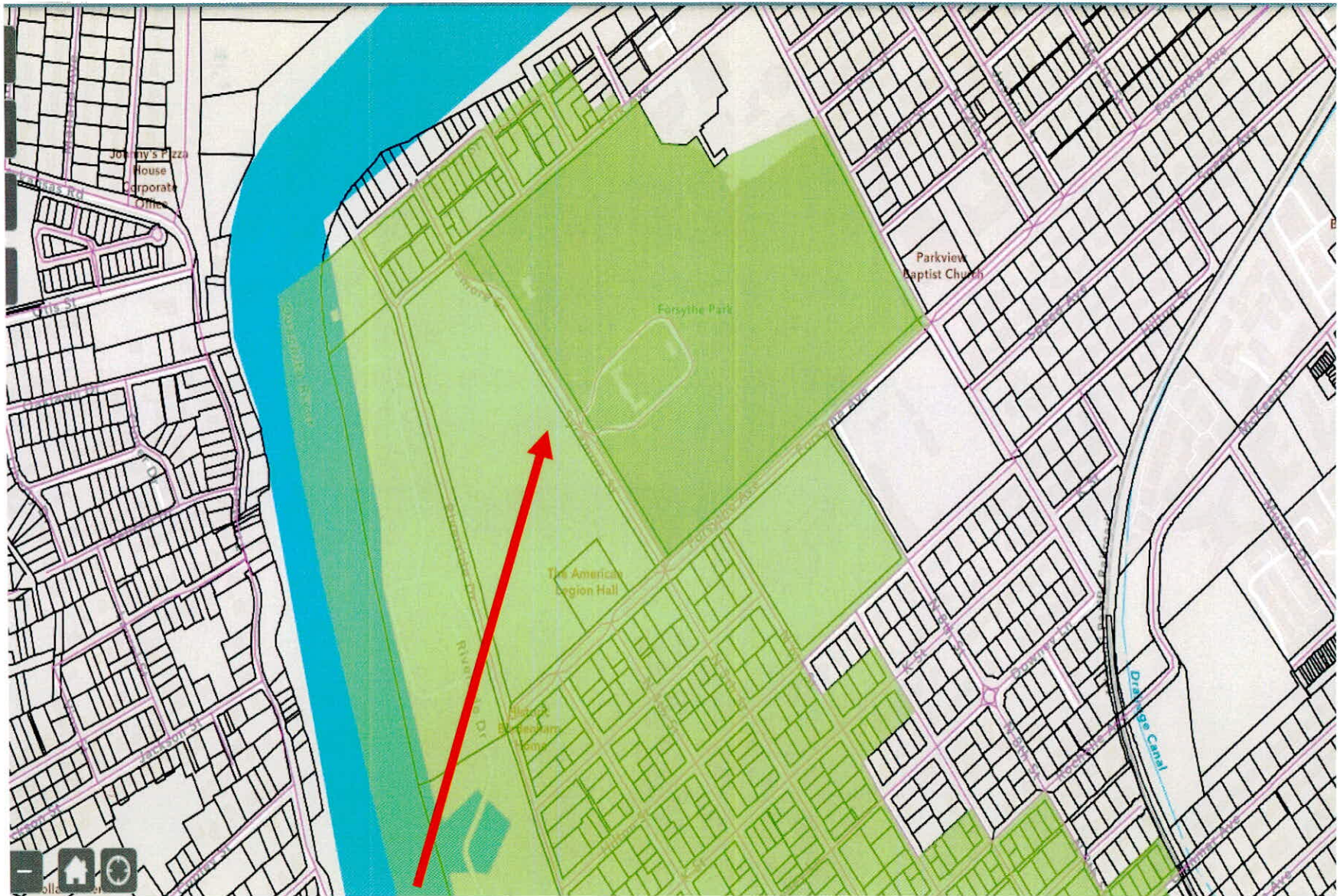
